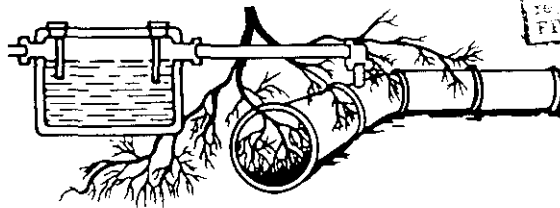

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hi-Yield Root Killer is formulated to quickly and economically kill and dissolve roots from trees and shrubs that have entered the sewer line. When used every 3 to 4 months, Hi-Yield Root Killer will prevent root stoppage and fungus growth. It kills the roots that have entered the pipe lines without harm to trees and shrubs outside the sewer. It will not corrode sewer or drain pipes leading into or out of septic tanks, and it will not harm necessary bacterial action in septic tanks or cesspools. By keeping pipes clear of roots and fungi, Hi-Yield Root Killer will prevent the formation of odorous gases.

The ideal time to apply this product is before retiring at night, when the use of utilities is low. To apply, pour 1/2 of the crystals into a toilet bowl. Immediately flush the toilet repeatedly until all the crystals have been flushed down. Repeat this procedure until the entire contents have been flushed down. As a preventive against stoppage, make the above application every 3 to 4 months.

For complete stoppage, use 4 to 6 lbs. and repeat in 7 to 10 days. If serious or complete blockage occurs, ropping may be necessary to assure some flow before treatment. This product may also be used through a distribution box direct to septic tank drainfield. Add sufficient water by hose or pail to carry crystals to point of root penetration or blockage. Do not apply this product through tub or sink drains.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes eye damage. Do not get into eyes. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wash hands after handling. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.
