These weeds will not be controlled if they are present in the lawn at the time of application. Apply in Fall to prevent winter weeds such as Henbit, Chickweed, Rabbit Tobacco and Evening Primrose. To kill other listed weeds, apply anytime weeds are present and actively growing. Repeat in 2 months if needed.

If soil is dry, water thoroughly the day before treatment. Treat entire lawn evenly. Immediately after application, water to wash particles of grass blades.

NOTE: Don't apply under the brand spread (root-zone) area of trees and shrubs in compact, slowly draining soils (particularly in the Dallas/Ft. Worth area).
