1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?
 Ferti-lome IMPROVED ROSE SPRAY was compounded to kill harmful sucking and chewing insects and to control damaging Black Spot and Botrytis Blossom Blight on healthy, beautiful roses. Use Ferti-lome IMPROVED ROSE SPRAY to kill leaf-eating insects that most frequently attack and damage roses: Rose Aphids, Rose Curculio, Rose Scale, Rose Leafhoppers, Western Flower Thrips, Rose Grass Aphids, Rose Flea Beetles, Rose Chaffer, Rose Slugs, Webworms, Oblique-banded Leafroller, Fruit-tree Leafroller, Tent Caterpillars, Apple Leafhoppers, San Jose Scale, Woad-bud Mites, Two-spotted Mites, Cyclamen Mites, Potato Aphids, Greenhouse Whitefly, Lesser Apple Worm, Greenhouse Leafhopper and Fire Beetles.
