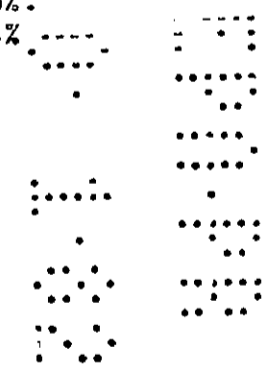

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This ready to use product will kill Fire Ants and eliminate unsightly and destructive mounds in lawns, lots, parks, school yards, pastureland, and other areas where Fire Ants can pose possible health hazards and damage land.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Shake well before using. Remove cap, turn jug upside down and sprinkle the 1 gallon contents on the Fire Ant mound. Thoroughly wet mound and surrounding area to a 4 foot diameter (12.5 Sq.ft.). For best results, apply in cool weather 65° - 80°F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear. If possible, treat all mounds in the vicinity, and treat all new colonies which may not as yet have constructed a mound.

To refill this one gallon container, pour 2 ozs. Hi-Yield FIRE ANT KILLER (Concentrate) into empty jug and finish filling with clean water.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT!

When used as directed, this product will eliminate Fire Ants and their mounds and provide for lawns, lots, parks, school yards, pastureland and other areas that are safer and more attractive.

DISPOSAL

When empty container is discarded, wrap container and put in trash collection.
