1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

ferti-lome READY TO USE VEGETABLE INSECT SPRAY kills destructive insects FAST ... on tomatoes, beans, peas, cabbage, corn, cucumbers, peppers, spinach, celery, asparagus, broccoli, cauliflower, brussels sprouts, eggplants, lettuce, mustard greens, kale, collards, turnips, potatoes & radishes.

KILLS: Aphids, Bean Leaf Beetles, Tomato Fruitworms, Leafhoppers, Cabbageworms, Japanese Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetles, Flea Beetles, Webworms, Cabbage Loopers, Whiteflies, Harlequin Bugs, Fireworms, Stink Bugs, Diamond-Back Caterpillars, Green Peach Aphids.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Shake well before using. Using the convenient trigger sprayer, spray with slow sweeping motions to cover upper & lower leaf surfaces and stems with a fine spray mist. Make applications when insects first appear. For Corn Ear Worm, spray into corn silk, and make three to four applications in two day intervals. Always reapply this product after rain. Regular light sprayings are better than single, heavy treatments. Repeat applications as needed. Stop use 1 day before harvest. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90 F. For best results, apply in late evening and early morning when temperatures are cool.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT!

When used as directed, this fast-acting product will kill destructive insects and thus help provide for healthier and more productive vegetable plants.

DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Protect from freezing. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
