1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

ferti-lome BAGWORM & TENT CATERPILLAR KILLER is formulated as a specific and positive method for killing Bagworms and Tent Caterpillars on evergreens (Arborvitae, Spruce, Cedar, Juniper, etc.), trees, shrubs and other ornamentals.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Mix 5 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water. Using any hose-on or other garden sprayer, spray entire leaf surface thoroughly when bagworms or tent caterpillars appear. Repeat as necessary to maintain control.

NOTE: Do not use on food crops in home gardens. Do not apply to lawn grasses or turf areas.

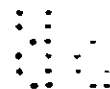
