DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This product is especially formulated for all-purpose garden and lawn uses. This insecticide-miticicide-fungicide combination kills leaf chewing and sap sucking insects and controls listed diseases on shrubs, lawns, vegetables, flowers, fruit & shade trees.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Mix 4 tablespoons (2 ozs.) in one gallon of water. Apply to thoroughly wet upper & lower leaf surfaces and stems. Spray when insects or their damage appear or when disease appear. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals as needed.

VEGETABLES - Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
