To apply, thoroughly dust upper and lower surfaces of plant foliage. Frequent light dustings are more effective than single heavy dusings. Where soil applications are required follow directions listed after the crop heading. Begin applications before disease appears or at first sign of disease. Where lower and higher rates of application are shown, use the higher rate when disease conditions are severe. VEGETABLES

BEANS: Anthracnose, Downy Mildew, Rust: Apply 1 lb. to cover 800 sq.ft. Repeat at 4-10 day intervals or as necessary to maintain control. Damping-Off, Root Rot: Apply 1½-2 lbs. per 800 sq.ft. Work into the top 3-4 inches of the soil at planting time. TOMATOES: Early & Late Blight, Anthracnose, Septoria Leaf Spot, Gray Leaf Spot (Stemphylium)-Young Plants-Apply ½-1/3 lb. to 450 sq.ft. Mature Plants-Increase to

¹-1 lb. per 450 sq.ft. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals. CANTALOUPES, CUCUMBERS, SUMMER & WINTER SQUASH, WATERMELONS, PUMPKINS: Downy "11dew, Angular Leaf Spot, Anthracnose-Apply 1 lb. to 600 sq.ft. Continue applications at weekly intervals as needed.

PEPPERS: Anthracnose, Cercospora(Frogeye Leaf Spot & Stem End Rot)-Apply 1 lb. to 800 sq.ft. Apply at 3-7 day intervals throughout growing season.

POTATOES: Early & Late Blight - Apply 1 1b. to 800 sq. t. Begin when plants are 2-4 inches high or at first sign of disease. Repeat at 5-7 day intervals.

POTATOES (Seed Pieces): Damping-Off, Seed Rot-Dust 1 lb. per bushel cut seed pieces. Cut pieces should be treated within 6 hours of cutting. If planting is to be delayed more than 1 or 2 days the treated pieces should be stored for 2 to 3 days in open crates before bagging. Do not use treated seed for food or feed purposes. LETTUCE: Downy Mildew-Apply 1 lb. to cover 900 sq.ft. Repeat at 5-10 day intervals. CARROTS: Septoria Leaf Spot, Early Blight (Cercospora Blight)-Apply 1 lb. to 300 sq.ft. Repeat at 6-10 day intervals.

BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER: Damping-Off: Apply 1 1b. to 300 sq.ft. Work into upper 3-4 inches of soil as a pre-planting treatment.

STRAWBERRIES: Botrytis Rot(Gray Mold), Leaf Spots: Apply 1 1b. to 600 sq.ft. Begin at new growth. Repeat at 7 day intervals through picking and after harvest. FLOWERS & SHRUBS

ROSES; Black Spot, Botrytis Blossom Blight. CARNATIONS; Alternaria Leaf Spot, Rust. CHRYSANTHEMUM; Botrytis Flower Blight, Septoria Leaf Spot. AZALEAS; Petal Blight -Apply 1 lb. to 800 sq.ft. Repeat at 7-14 day intervals and more frequently during frequent rains and heavy dews. For Azaleas, make applications only through bloom. CAMELLIAS: Petal Blight - Apply & 1b. to 800 sq.ft. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals. Apply only through bloom.

LAWNS, TURF: Brown Patch, Damping-Off, Leaf Spots, Copper Spot, Melting Out, Seedling Blights - Apply 1 1b. to 350 sq.ft. Repeat at 7-14 day intervals throughout season. Ec not graze treated areas or feed treated clippings to livestock.

STORAGE: Store in original contailor and place in a locked storage area. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
