Before applying, water lawn thoroughly using 2 to 5 gallons of water per 1,000 sq.ft.

Brown Patch - Apply 5 lbs. per 1,250 sq.ft. (4 lbs/1,000 sq.ft.) beginning at first sign of disease. Repeat at 10 to 14 day intervals if necessary. When conditions are favorable for disease (moist & warm) repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals.

Dollar Spot - Apply 5 lbs. per 2,500 sq.ft. (2 lbs/1,000 sq.ft.) beginning at first sign of disease. Repeat at 10 to 14 day intervals if necessary.

Fusarium Blight - Apply 5 lbs. per 500 sq.ft. (10 lbs/1,000 sq.ft.) beginning at first sign of disease. In severe cases, apply 5 lbs. per 300 sq.ft. (16 lbs/1,000 sq.ft.) Water immediately after application with sufficient water to thoroughly wet the soil. Repeat at 10 to 14 day intervals if necessary.

Fusarium Patch - (Pink Snow Mold) - Apply 5 lbs. per 1,250 sq.ft. (4 lbs/1,000 sq.ft.) beginning at first sign of disease. Repeat at 10 to 14 day intervals if necessary.

Striped Saut - Apply 5 lbs. per 400 sq.ft. (12 lbs/1,000 sq.ft.). Make one application in early spring before grass begins to grow. Water lawn immediately after application with sufficient water to carry product to the soil.


