Hi-Yield Dormant Spray is effective in controlling a wide range of Scales, Mites, Fruit Tree Leaf Rollers, Pear Psylla, Fall Armyworms & Whiteflies on Ornamentals, Shrubs, Fruit Trees and Shade Trees such as: tea scale on camellias, oleander scale on oleanders, juniper scale on junipers, azalea scale on azaleas, white peach scale on privet, scale on citrus trees, rose scale on roses and magnolia scales on magnolias.

ORNAMENTALS: Mix 3 tablespoons (1½ fl. ozs.) in 1 gallon of water. Spray foliage thoroughly. Do not spray plants in mid-day with this spray if temperature is above 90°F. Spray in late afternoon or early morning. Hi-Yield Dormant Spray may be mixed with other insecticides and with fungicides except those containing sulphur. Hi-Yield Dormant Spray may cause plant injury in house plants such as ivy, ferns, and the like.

FRUIT TREES: To control San Jose scale on peaches, plums, pears, apple trees, obscure scale on pecans; spray trees thoroughly (during dormant season only) with 6 tablespoons (3 fl. ozs.) in 1 gallon of water. Repeat in 3 to 4 weeks if necessary.

Hi-Yield Dormant Spray is an effective and economical way to control scale on Ornamentals, Shrubs, Shade Trees and Fruit Trees.

STORAGE: Store in original container and place in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
