Revised Labeling and Confidential Statement of Formula Follow-up to March 1, 1999, Notice of Intent to Suspend

Your letter of July 8, 1999

On March 1, 1999, the Agency sent your company a Notice of Intent to Suspend for failure to respond to the Data Call-In of October 1988. The suspension became effective in early April 1999. To comply with the DCI, you elected to delete food uses from your label and to revise your Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) to show a supplier whose label permits the remaining uses on your label. Our review follows below.

#### A. Revised Label

The labeling submitted with the above letter is acceptable, provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling with the following changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. Revise your "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" as follows:

# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

2. Delete the sentence, "Avoid storage near steam pipes and radiators." from the "Physical or Chemical Hazards" section. Modify your "Storage" section as follows:

Storage: Store only in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets and away from steam pipes and radiators.

This registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e) if you do not comply with these conditions. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. However, you may not ship this product until you have received formal, written notice that the Agency has 1) lifted the suspension for this product and 2) lifted any stop sales (if any were imposed).

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

## B. Revised CSF

1. The Agency has determined that the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), dated July 8, 1999, which was submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. A copy of this CSF has been placed in our file for this product. All previous versions are obsolete.
