This product is registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) provided that you make the following label corrections and submit one copy of the revised finished printed label incorporating these corrections before the product is released for shipment:

- 1. Add the designation EPA Reg. No. 7401-463.
- 2. The efficacy label claims listed below do not appear on the product label cited as your source product on your CSF, are thus not supported under your "100% repackage scenario" and must be removed. Such claims are public health pest claims and must be supported by appropriate efficacy data.

The claims "Kills the queen", Destroys the mound", "Colonies are destroyed within 3 to 7 days." and "Kills fire ant workers within hours"

3. The claim "ants (including fire ants and harvester ants)" must be revised to read as follows: imported fire ants. The claim for ants other than imported fire ants does not appear on the source product label for the sites listed on the subject product label.

- 4. Correct the reentry statement ("Do not allow children or pets to come into contact with treated areas until sprays have dried.") to read as follows: "Do not allow children or pets to come into contact with treated areas until dusts have settled."
- 5. Since you have verified that the subject product is intended for residential use, and the label bears the statement "For use as a mound treatment on home lawns", revise the use sites as specified below.
 - Correct the site "turfgrass" and "non-crop areas" to "home lawns".
- 6. Remove the claim ("around ornamental plants (including flowers"). This use site does not appear on the source product label for fire ants.
- 7. Correct the warranty and disclaimer statements as cited below to avoid misleading and/or overly broad statements. Refer to the Agency document entitled Guidance on Warranty Statements dated October 17, 2006. This document is located on the Agency's website at http://www.epa.gov/pesticides/regulating/labels/warranty.pdf . The attachment contains examples of problematic warranty statements.

Add the phrase "to the extent consistent with applicable law" to the beginning of the second ("VOLUNTARY PURCHASING GROUPS, INC. MAKES NO OTHER ___".) and the last sentence ("IN NO CASE WILL VOLUNTARY PURCHASING GROUPS __".) of the warranty paragraph.
