Your submission dated December 13, 1996

This amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. On front panel add "For use in and around the home and other residential sites only."

b. Before Roaches, Waterbugs, etc. add

"INDOOR USE

Precautions: 1) Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray: take care not to introduce this product into the air during application. 2) Use only in well ventilated areas. 3) Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. 4) Remove or cover fish bowls and remove pets before application. 5) Do not treat pets or plants with this product. 6) Do not allow children or

pets in treated areas until spray has dried. 7) If clothing is sprayed during application, remove clothing immediately after spraying and launder before wearing again. 8) Do not apply directly to carpets or floor coverings and avoid excessive wetting on asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials because damage may occur. 9) Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls, wall coverings, and fabrics. 10) Do not apply directly to upholstery or furniture. 11) Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will contact food or feed. 12) Exposed food should be covered or removed during application. 13) All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during application and thoroughly washed with soap and water before use. 14) Do not use in conduits, motor housings or electrical switch boxes."

c. The indoor uses and the outdoor uses should be grouped with the appropriate precautions and uses and the heading "INDOOR USES" and "OUTDOOR USES".

d. following the statement will not stain woodwork add: "Discard infested food packages, but do not spray inside cabinets where food is stored."

e. Under Ants delete "electrical outlets".

f. Under Flies, Mosquitoes, etc. add to the first sentence "For outdoor use only as an aid ...".

g. Add under OUTDOOR USE (newly created heading before Flies, Mosquitoes, etc.) "PRECAUTIONS: 1) Spray with wind to your back. If clothing becomes wet from spray during use, remove clothing after spraying, wash affected body areas thoroughly with soap and water and launder clothing before wearing again. 2) Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas under spray has dried. 3) Do not apply to lawns or other desirable plants."

h. Under Directions For Use change "Federal Law" to "Federal law".

i. Replace the Hazards To Humans and Domestic section with "Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeat contact with skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Do not use on household pets or humans. Remove pets from area, and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until sprayed surfaces have dried."

j. Replace the **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT** section with "IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING UNLESS NO OTHER TREATMENT IS AVAILABLE. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and inset finger in back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention. IF ON SKIN: Wash promptly with soap and water. Get medical attention. IF IN EYES: Rinse eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN section with "This product is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered but only in conjunction with atropine. This product contains a petroleum distillate solvent, which may present an aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if product was taken internally."

k. Add the following **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** section "This pesticide is highly toxic to birds, fish, and other wildlife. Birds feeding or drinking on treated area may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by disposal."

l. Replace the **Physical Hazards or Chemical Hazards** section with "Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 degrees fahrenheit may cause bursting."

m. Add the following **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** section with "Storage: Keep away from fire, sparks, and heat. See Physical or Chemical Hazards for additional precautions. Store in an area inaccessible to children and pets. Store in original container only. Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection."

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3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

ANTS: Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door frames and window sills. It is frequently desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants come into rooms from wall spaces and partition.

SPIDERS AND SCORPIONS: Spray wherever these insects may enter the home, such as around door frames and window sills. In garages, wood houses, cabins, outhouses, spray until wet where these insects crawl.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, JUNE BUGS, FLYING MOTHS: As an aid to reduce the annoyance from these insects in entering the home, spray the outer surfaces of screens, doors and window frames and other places such as open porch fixtures where these insects gather.
