## DO NOT SPRAY IN AIR AS A SPACE SPRAY

**DIRECTION FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
Remove the cap. Hold can upright. Point valve opening away from face. Press button to release spray.

### INDOOR USE

Precautions: 1) Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray; take care not to introduce this product into the air during application. 2) Use only in well ventilated areas. 3) Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. 4) Remove or cover fish bowls and remove pets before application. 5) Do not treat pets or plants with this product. 6) Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until spray has dried. 7) If clothing is sprayed during application, remove clothing immediately after spraying and launder before wearing again. 8) Do not apply directly to carpets or floor coverings and avoid excessive wetting on asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials because damage may occur. 9) Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls, wall coverings, and fabrics. 10) Do not apply directly to upholstery or furniture. 11) Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will contact food or feed. 12) Exposed food should be covered during application. 13) All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during application and thoroughly washed with soap and water before use. 14) Do not use in condunits, motor housing or electrical switch boxes.

**ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, CARPET BEETLES:** Spray infested cracks and hiding places thoroughly. Direct spray into moist places, and around sinks, bath tubs, drains, laundry tubs, pipes through walls and floors. Spray behind cabinets, sashes, refrigerators and counters. Will not stain woodwork. Discard infested food packages, but do not spray inside cabinets where food is stored. To control beetles - spray the underside of carpets.

**ANTS:** Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door frames and window sills. It is frequently desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts and baseboards where ants come into rooms from wall spaces and partitions.

**SPIDERS AND SCORPIONS:** Spray wherever these insects may enter the home, such as around door frames and window sills. In garages, wood houses, cabins, outhouses, spray until wet where these insects crawl.

### OUTDOOR USE

Precautions: 1) Spray with wind at your back. If clothing becomes wet from spray during use, remove clothing after spraying, wash affected body areas thoroughly with soap and water and launder clothing before wearing again. 2) Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. 3) Do not apply to lawns or other desirable plants.

**FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, JUNE BUGS, FLYING MOTHS:** For outdoor use only as an aid to reduce the annoyance from these insects in entering the home, spray the outer surfaces of screens, doors and window frames and other places such as open porch fixtures where these insects gather.

### REPEAT TREATMENT AS NECESSARY FOR EFFECTIVE CONTROL SPRAY INFESTED SURFACES UNTIL WET

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeat contact with skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
