FOR OUTDOOR USE: Can also be used in attics, warehouses and other storage areas where foods and feedstuffs are not exposed.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

DIRECTIONS FOR OUTDOOR USE: Hold can upright. Point nozzle away from face and in direction of the space to be treated. With wind at back, aim at nests in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks or crevices, etc. Spray while moving away from treated areas. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying treated areas. Thoroughly saturate nest with spray, contacting as many insects as possible. To prevent insects from falling on skin and clothes, do not stand directly under nest. Best results can be obtained if nest is sprayed in late evening when most insects are at nest. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment.

DIRECTIONS FOR INDOOR USE: Same as for outdoor use but do not spray in areas where food and feedstuffs are exposed or handled.

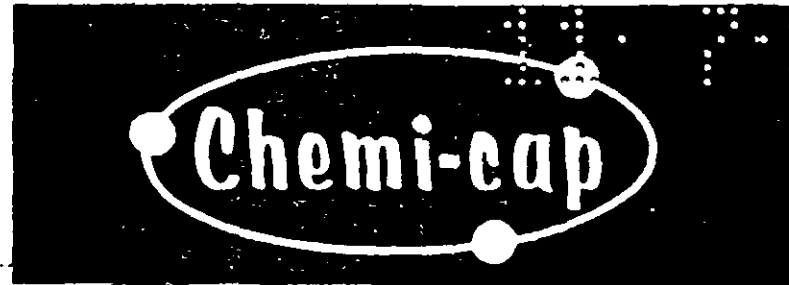
Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F. may cause bursting.
