Dear Mr. Colker:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1) You must submit a corrected CSF. This submission showed a lower limit for product 432-433 of 5.82%. The percentage of Resmethrin in this product is 28.4%, so the correct lower limit would be 0.582% and the percentage by weight is 0.6%. Apparently, you shifted the decimal point inadvertently.

2) Change the ingredient statement to read as follows:

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS
Resmethrin.....0.170%
*INERT INGREDIENTS.....99.830%

* Contains Petroleum distillate

3) Add signal word "CAUTION" to back label immediately before precautionary statement paragraph.

4) Add the following precautionary statement:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters.

~~5) The statement of practical treatment should be moved away from the middle of the precautionary statements.~~

DIRECTIONS FOR OUTDOOR USE: Hold can upright. Using JET STREAMER FOGGER NOZZLE, point nozzle away from face and in direction of the space to be treated. When interchanging from jet to fogger nozzle, be careful not to spray into face or eyes. With wind at back, aim at nest in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks or crevices, etc. Spray while moving away from treated area. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying treated area. Thoroughly saturate nest with spray, contacting as many insects as possible. To prevent insects from falling on skin and clothes, do not stand directly under nest. Best results can be obtained if nest is sprayed in late evening when most insects are at nest. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment.

DIRECTIONS FOR INDOOR USE: Same as for outdoor use but do not spray in areas where food or feedstuffs are exposed or handled

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Direct spray away from people or animals. May cause eye irritation. Avoid breathing spray mist. Allow spray to disperse for several minutes before entering the treated area. Harmful or fatal if swallowed; avoid contact with skin. Avoid smoking while spraying. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

EXCESSIVE INHALATION: Remove to fresh air and call a physician.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

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
