DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one bomb for each 10,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Can be used manually or valve can be locked in open position. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press seal edge firmly until it locks under outer ring.

FOR FLIES, FLEAS, TICKS, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND MOTHS (MILLERS): For best results first spray distant rooms manually, spraying toward ceiling room with mist. Place bomb on stand or table in center of unobstructed room then lock valve open. Leave building at once and keep building closed 2 hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air thoroughly. Repeat when necessary.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, Earwigs, Grain Mites, Sowbugs, Spiders and Centipedes — Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, basements and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

FOR ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat if necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing. Avoid breathing mist. Use as a space spray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. Food contact surfaces and equipment must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse. In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated 2 hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Contains petroleum distillate. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL/CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat, sparks or open flame. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 54°C may cause bursting. Do not use on polished wood furniture or fabrics.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep in a cool, dry, locked area away from flame, sparks and sources of heat or ignition. Containers heated above 130°F (54°C) may burst.

DISPOSAL: Retasten cap on container and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
