DIRECTIONS:

(I) Spray the interior of the aircraft (7405-54) with this insecticide at a rate of not less than 5 pints per 1,000 cubic feet of space in the aircraft, and shall be released or sprayed through the accessible compartments.

(II) Disinsectization may be accomplished either while the aircraft is in flight or while on the ground prior to takeoff, but in no case shall disinsectization be accomplished later than 30 minutes prior to the first landing at a United States port.

(III) The ventilation system shall be stopped and all openings to the exterior kept closed while the insecticide is being released or sprayed, and for a period of not less than 30 minutes thereafter. If disinsectization is accomplished on the ground prior to takeoff, the ventilation system may be opened at the end of each period, provided that the system is equipped with filter or other means for preventing the entrance of insects into the aircraft, but doors, windows, or other such opening to the exterior shall be kept closed until after the takeoff, except in the case of emergency, or to permit persons applying the insecticide to debark.

TO OPERATE ATOMIZER
