Close doors and windows. Pull valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** Remove overcap. Pull cap away from face. Invert cap and lock onto valve stem. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave bedding at once and keep bedding closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

**TO KILL TICKS:** Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Apply this product as for other insects. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after treatment. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

**TO KILL FLEAS:** Follow directions for ticks but use one unit per 1,500 cubic feet of room space.
