The labeling referred to above, and the alternate confidential statement of formula submitted 4/29/96, both submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Add the following footnote to the inert or "other" ingredients: "Contains petroleum distillate."

You may delete the chemical name which follows, in parenthesis, tetramethrin in the ingredient statement.

You may delete the statement "Do not get in eyes" from the Precautionary Statements, as it is redundant.

The heading "Statement of Practical Treatment" may be changed to "First Aid".

The disposal statement must read as follows:
Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

The "If Swallowed" statement must be changed to read as follows:
Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol.

Thoroughly saturate nest with spray, contacting as many insects as possible. To prevent insects from falling on skin and clothes, do not stand directly under nest. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment.
