On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

b. On the front panel either delete "Residual Effects Controls Fleas and ticks" or add the time period for residual effects based upon efficacy data, i.e., residual effects for _____ (weeks, month) etc..

c. Under Directions for Use change "Federal Law" to "federal law".

d. Under Statement of Practical Treatment you may delete the "IF IN EYES, IF ON SKIN AND IF SWALLOWED" sections.

e. Move the "Do not use in food/feed...is in operation." to under Directions for Use. Add the following after the preceding sentences "Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Nonfood areas where the product can be used are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling). Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use."

f. The submitted Confidential Statement of Formula should be corrected to a basic formulation since it is a first registration for this product.

g. On the front panel identify the sites where the product can be used such as: "For Commercial/Agricultural Use in Non-food areas of industrial and institution buildings: homes, schools, warehouses, office buildings, theaters, garages, hotels, motels".

h. Delete the bullet "contains natural pyrethrins".

i. Add "Not for Use in USDA Federally inspected Meat and Poultry Plants."

j. Add the following statement under precautionary Statements: "Allow all treated items to thoroughly dry before use."

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray form a distance of 12 to 15 inches.
DUAL SPRAY VALVE: PUSH BUTTON DOWN FOR MIST TO CONTROL FLYING INSECTS OR FORWARD FOR PENCIL SPRAY TO CONTROL CRAWLING INSECTS.
INDOOR USES

For residual and contact control of:
COCKROACHES, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS AND PILLBUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray when ever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLYING INSECTS: Cluster Flies, House Flies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room, moving toward the door. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

FLEAS IN BUILDINGS — SPACE SPRAY: Hold can 36 inches above floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walls at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq. ft. making sure that all floor, sofa and chair surfaces are contacted. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes. Open and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment after 7 days or as needed.

FLEAS AND TICKS (ADULTS AND LARVAE): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture and mattresses may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

TO KILL LICE AND LOUSE EGGS: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for three seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that can not be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

OUTDOOR USES

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and Small Flying Moths. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Repeat as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Centipedes and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use on serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with water for 15 minutes, lifting upper and lower lids. If irritation persists, call a physician.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing; immediately wash off affected skin with soap and water.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to any body of water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, potholes). Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not apply to conduits, motor housings, junctions and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area. Do not transport or store below 32°F. Replace cap and wrap container in several layers of newspaper. Discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
