DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and direct spray away from face. Press valve down and spray as directed. Spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 4 ounces product to treat approximately 25 square feet of surface area.

Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use.

Do not use in commercial food / feed areas of food / feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food / feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Not for use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

INDOORS

COCKROACHES, ANTS, CCENTIPEDES, CRICKETS, FLEAS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, TICKS and WATERBUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

ANTS: Spray freely around ant trails, doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises. Spray around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray freely on and around debris.

SPIDERS: Apply along and behind baseboards, to window and doorframes, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these insects may crawl.

If infestation reappears, repeat treatment but not more than once a week and no more than twelve times per year.

OUTDOORS

ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, CENTIPEDES: Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel Ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes and sowbugs (pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps.

NON-FOOD AREAS: May be used as a crack and crevice treatment or as a spot application in non-food areas. All areas where insects hide or through which insects may enter should be treated.

Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

If infestation reappears repeat treatment but not more than once a week and no more than twelve times per year.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after first five minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by a poison control center or doctor.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Prolonged or frequent repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash thoroughly after handling. Remove and wash clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of food and feed.

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Physical Or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool dry area away from children.

Container Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard as trash. Do not incinerate or puncture. Can may be disposed with other recyclables where local law permits.
