USE	AMOUNT	DIRECTIONS
MACHINE LAUNDERING: for white and color fast cotton and linen; white nylon, rayon, Dacron, Orlon, acetate. Acrilan, Arnel and blends of these fibres.	Top loading automatics and wringer washers -- use 1 cup Loblaws Bleach per load; front loading washers, 1/2 cup per load.	Add Loblaws Bleach to wash water before adding laundry, if possible, or dilute Loblaws Bleach in quart of water before adding. Rinse. With Automatic Bleach Dispensers, follow washer directions.
HAND LAUNDERING: for same fabrics listed above.	1 tablespoonful Loblaws Bleach per gallon of water.	Add Loblaws Bleach to the water and mix thoroughly before adding laundry. Rinse.
DIAPERS: for deodorizing, disinfecting and removing stains.	In diaper pail pre-soak, use 1 tablespoonful Loblaws Bleach per gallon water. Mix well. To wash diapers, use same amount as regular laundry.	Flush out soiled diapers, then immerse in Loblaws Bleach solution in diaper pail. Follow regular laundering directions. Always rinse thoroughly.
STUBBORN STAINS: for removing fruit, berry, wine, coffee, tea, chocolate, vegetable, flower, grass, blood, and many ink, dye and medicine stains; also scorch and mildew.	2 tablespoonfuls Loblaws Bleach to quart of cold water or 1/2 cup to gallon. Mix well.	Immerse fabric 5 to 15 minutes; rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary. Colored fabrics -- test small piece before using. Use in glass, rubber, porcelain or enameled containers.
"AGE-YELLOWED" NYLON: to whiten yellowed or gray 100% Nylon, Dacron or Rayon.	2 tablespoonfuls Loblaws Bleach to 1 gallon warm water.	Immerse clean fabric 15 to 30 minutes in solution. Repeat if necessary.
AS DISINFECTANT, DEODORIZER OR STAIN REMOVER: for bathtubs, basins, showers, refrigerators, sinks, drainboards, linoleum, porcelain, tile, marble, woodwork, wood utensils, vases, dishcloths, enamel ware, garbage cans, sick room equipment.
