For transplanting ornamental SHRUBS and TREES, mix with Alpha Naphthalene Acetic Acid" in 1 gallon of water for each plant.

INDOOR PLANTS

For transplanting POTTED PLANTS, ROOTED CUTTINGS use one teaspoonful per gallon of water. Applications should be made until the plants are well established. Subsequent applications are a plant growth and root stimulant, NOT A FERTILIZER.
