PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DO NOT TAKE INTERNALLY. DO NOT GET IN EYES. DO NOT GET ON SKIN. CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe dust, get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and warm water before re-use. If poisoning occurs, obtain prompt medical aid. Keep granules away from dogs and pets. Bait may be attractive to dogs. Confine pets during application to prevent them from believing they are being feed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ ENTIRE LABEL USE IN ACCORDANCE WITH PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS FOR USE. DO NOT APPLY DIRECTLY ONTO PLANTS.** Do not allow bait to contact the edible portions of any food crop.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store product in original labeled container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not store in direct sunlight. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by State & local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke. **HOUSEHOLD:** Do not reuse empty container. Use in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

IMPORTANT - HOW TO USE

Read entire label before using. LAST-BITE Snail & Slug Killer Pellets is a bait product formulated for control of Snails and Slugs. The pests will be attracted to the pellets and will be killed quickly. These pests are night feeders and their presence can be detected by their shiny mucous-like trails. They seek shelter during the day in protected, cool areas and generally hide in damp locations around flower beds, ornamentals, hedges, and especially in low-growing cover, such as ivy, Dichondra lawns and young bedding plants. LAST-BITE Snail & Slug Killer Pellets should be broadcast late in the day, before or after thoroughly wetting the areas suspected to be infested. During periods of damp weather or continuous watering the pellets multiply rapidly and it may be necessary to reapply bait at two week intervals - even more frequently during extremely heavy infestations. New broods can usually be controlled by 3 baittings at 10 day intervals. Best results are obtained if soil is wet before use and dry soil should be moistened before application. Do not allow Pellets to come in contact with parts of plant that may be used for food or feed purposes. Apply any time of the day but evening applications are preferred. Do not re-water for 48 hours after application.

APPLICATION

Use 1 lb. to treat 1,100 sq. ft. For control of SNAILS and SLUGS on surface equivalent to 30 to 40 pounds of soil when first plant damage appears or nearby for control.

FRUIT TREE

Apply at the rate of 1 lb. per 1,100 sq. ft. to APPLES, APRICOTS, AVOCADO, PEARS, and CITRUS; (Oranges, Lemons, and Grapefruit) cast liberally under trees, around trunks, and any other place where slugs or snails are present.

BERRY CROPS

Use up to 40 lb. per acre. BLACKBERRIES, BOYSENBERRY, RASPBERRIES, STRAWBERRIES, For snail and slug control.

VEGETABLE CROPS

Apply up to 30 to 40 lb. per acre. For use around Artichoke, Asparagus, Beans, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Eggplant, Endive, Garlic, Kohlrabi, Leeks, Lettuce, Melons, Parsnips, Peas, Peppers, Pimientos, Spinach, Rhubarb, Rutabagas, Salads, Sweet Potatoes, Swiss Chard, Tomatoes.

ORNAMENTAL GARDENS

One pound will cover 1,100 sq. ft. ORNAMENTAL GARDENS, PLANT BEDS, PATIO COVERS: Including Azaleas, Begonias, Camellias, Daffodils, Dahlias, Geraniums, Impatiens, Iris, Lilies, Rhododendron, Rose, Sweet Peas, Spathephyllum, Tulips. Water the infested area before application. Broadcast or sprinkle evenly 3-5 inches over the infested area. Do not re-water for 48 hours.

DICHLONDRA AND/OR TURFGRASS

One pound will cover 1,100 sq. ft. Water infested area thoroughly before application. Broadcast LAST-BITE Snail & Slug Killer Pellets evenly. Do not re-water for 48 hours.

ORNAMENTAL GREENHOUSES

One pound will cover 1,100 sq. ft. Water or irrigate greenhouse soil to moisten before application. Broadcast LAST-BITE Snail & Slug Killer Pellets under benches in greenhouses, under benches in greenhouses, under benches in greenhouses, under benches in greenhouses. apply directly to plants unless plants are to be tolerant to this product. Apply 1 lb. per 1,100 sq. ft. Alfalfa, Barley, Hay, Oats, Wheat, etc.
