FRUIT AND

Refer to chart and apply pellets to fruit crops. Do not apply to flowers. Treatments may be repeated every 2 weeks. 1 1/4 lb. per 1,250 sq.ft. Apply to flowers, Crickets, Darkling Beetles, and Sowbugs in the following crops during the waiting period; i.e. (waiting period)

CROPS
Cucumbers, Squash, Melons
Peas
Asparagus, Strawberries
Beans, Carrots, Corn, Eggplant, Okra, Peppers, Potatoes, Sweet Corn, Tomatoes
Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Head Lettuce, Garden Beets, (root) Horseradish, Parsnips, Radishes, Rutabagas, and Turnips
For Collards, Endive, (Escarole), Garden Beets (Tops), Kale, Leaf Lettuce, Parsley, Spinach, Swiss Chard, Turnips (Tops)
Apples, Apricots, Cherries, Citrus, Grapes, Nectarines, Peaches, Pears, Plums

FOR FOUNDATION TREATMENT, AROUND FLOWER BEDS

Apply 1 1/4 lb. per 1,250 sq.ft. areas for use in the control of worms, Armyworms, Cutworms, and other insects around the outside of porches and flower and ornamental buildings and as an insecticide surrounding the foundation of pellets in a 5 foot width.

NOTICE: Buyer and handler must read and understand the terms of this label.

LAST-BITE

SOWBUG, CUTWORM AND EARWIG KILLER is a specially formulated BAIT to attract and kill Cutworms, Sowbugs, Earwigs, Crickets, Darkling Beetles, Grasshoppers, Millipedes, Armyworms, and Ants that may eat or come in contact with the pellets. For use in and around Ornamentals, Ground Covers, Lawns, and certain listed Vegetables.

ORNAMENTALS, GROUND COVERS, LAWNS AND ORNAMENTAL TURF

For the control of Ants, Earwigs, Sow Bugs, Millipedes, Fall Armyworms start treatment at first sign of pest activity. Water area first, then do not water for a least 24 hours. Spread pellets lightly over area. Apply at the rate of 1 1/4 pounds per 1250 Sq.Ft. Sow bugs and Cutworms feed mainly at night. It is best to put out pellets in later afternoon or evening. Application should be repeated at 2-week intervals as long as needed.
