DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Spray thoroughly covering both upper and lower leaf surfaces or other infested plant parts. Repeat as necessary.

AVOCADO: Greenhouse thrips, Latania Scale, Soft brown scale, orange tortrix; Use 2 tsp. to gal. water. DO NOT use closer than 7 days of harvest.

Oranges, Grapefruit, Tangerines, Limes, Lemons, Tangelos, Kumquats — For the control of Florida Red Scale, Purple Scale, Soft Brown Scale; use 2 tsp. to a gal. Do not use when trees are in bloom nor later than 7 days before harvest. Do not exceed 2 gallons of this product per acre.

Ornamental Flowers & Shrubs — Against Scale insects such as Soft Brown Scale, Florida Red, Black Azalae, Magnolia, Pine Leaf Scale. and Euonymus, Juniper and Oyster Shell Scales; use 2 tsp. per gal. Apply any time of year. Against Aphids, Spider Mites, Mealybugs, Whiteflies, Tarnished Plantbugs, Leaf-hoppers, Thrips, Tent Caterpillars, Boxwood Leaf Miners and Lacebugs; use 2 tsp. per gal. of water. Spray for thorough coverage and repeat as needed.

Do NOT use on Fern or Foliage Plants as foliar injury may

result. Do NOT use on Hibiscus or Poinsettia.

Cabbage, Broccoli, Turnips, Mustard — Against Aphids.

Cabbage Loopers and imported Cabbage Worms: use 1 - 2
tsp. to 1 gal. water, 1 - 2 pts. per acre as full coverage spray
as needed, not later than 7 days before harvesting Cabbage
and Mustard or 3 days for Broccoli and Turnips.

Strawberries: For the control of field crickets, spider mites, spittle bug, strawberry leafroller, thrips, white flies; the spittle bug, to gal. water. Do not exceed 3 pints to an acre. Do not use closer than 3 days to harvest.

Tomatoes: For the control of aphids, spider mites: Use $1^{1/4}$ tsp. to gal. of water. Do not use closer than 1 day to harvest.
