Your application of June 12, 1978 requesting a change in product name and a general revision of the label has been reviewed and found to be provisionally acceptable. The correction of the following deficiencies will make the label acceptable:


1. Move the storage claims, "Store in a cool place, Do not store in direct sun light, Protect from freezing temperatures," into the block for Storage and Disposal claims.
2. Delete your claims "Do not combine colloidal suspensions, wettable powers or emulsifiable concentrates unless previous experience assures compatibility." These are new claims that must be supported with data. There is an implied claim for use of the subject product as an ingredient of mixtures, if compatibility. To support such a claim data must be submitted.
3. There is no objection to your adding the claim: "Mix thoroughly before use or use entire container at one time," if the product is reasonably homogenous. If there is a tendency for the product to settle out, then the statement should read: "Mix thoroughly before use." Submit data to show that product is homogenous or change the statement to read "Mix thoroughly before use."
4. Submit five (5) copies of final printed labels, reduced to readable copy on 8 1/2 x 11 inch paper.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CAPTAN 30-DD is especially formulated for treatment of seeds for the control of seed and soilborne diseases, including damping-off and seed decay organisms, and seedling blights.

Mix thoroughly before use.

This product is to be used in liquid or slurry treaters similar to Panomatic, Mist-O-Matic or Calkins.

The Federal Food and Drug Administration has set official tolerances for certain pesticide residues. In order that residues on food and forage crops will not exceed established tolerances, use only at recommended rates.
