

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CAPTAN 30-DD is especially formulated for treatment of seeds for the control of seed and soilborne diseases, including damping-off and seed decay organisms, and seedling blights.

Mix thoroughly before use or use entire container at one time. Do not combine colloidal suspensions, wettable powder or emulsifiable concentrates unless previous experience assures compatibility.

This product is to be used in liquid or slurry treaters similar to Panomatic, Mist-O-Matic or Calkins.

The Federal Food and Drug Administration has set official tolerances for certain pesticide residues. In order that residues on food and forage crops will not exceed established tolerances, use only at recommended rates.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- STORAGE**—Store in a cool place. Do not store in direct sunlight. Protect from freezing temperatures.
- PROHIBITIONS**—Do not re-use empty containers. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
