STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IN CASE OF CONTACT: Immediately flush eyes with running water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. IN CASE OF SKIN CONTACT: Wash the affected area with soap and warm water.

GENERAL USE PRECAUTIONS:

During commercial exposure, wear goggles, clean synthetic rubber gloves, protective clothing and a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part II.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

CONTAINER DISPOSAL
