Dear Mr. McFadden:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the following changes are made.

SIGNAL WORDS: move the phrase "Keep out of reach of children" and the signal word "DANGER" out of the First Aid box. Add the signal word "PELIGRO" next to "DANGER" Immediately below the Signal Words, add the following text:

"Si Usted no entiende la etiqueta, busque a alguien para que se la explique a Usted en detalle. (If you do not understand the label, find someone to explain it to you in detail.)"

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND ANIMALS: add the word "Corrosive." before the sentence "Causes irreversible eye damage."

USE PRECAUTIONS: in the second paragraph, after "chemical resistant gloves" add the words "made of any waterproof material".

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: change the subheading "STORAGE" to "PESTICIDE STORAGE."

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Please submit one (1) copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of State and Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Not for use on agricultural establishments in hopper-box, planter-box, slurry-box or other seed-treatment applications at or immediately before planting.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS—Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty containers

STORAGE—Store in a cool dry location. Do not store in direct hot sunlight. After prolonged storage in intense cold, allow product to return to approximately 25°F before using.
