STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IN CASE OF CONTACT: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water that runs freely for 15 minutes. In case of skin contact, wash the affected area with soap and water.

GENERAL USE PRECAUTIONS

During commercial application, wear goggles, heavy rubber gloves, and protective clothing against spray or dust. Do not eat, drink, or use tobacco during application. DIRECTIONS: Thoroughly mix with the recommended amount of Captan 400-D Seed Protectant into the required amount of water for the seed treatment equipment and apply to seed as directed. Clean equipment thoroughly between treatments.

IMPORTANT: Before using - stir thoroughly to mix contents. Do not use if the mixture is lumpy or if the time. Do not combine with other suspensions. Avoid eye contact with dust or spray. Do not use unless previous experience assures compatibility.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- 1. PROHIBITIONS** - Do not reuse empty containers. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open disposal is prohibited.
- 2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** - Pesticide sprays, mixtures, or residues that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of according to procedures outlined by Federal, State or local disposal authorities.
