

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
WARNING**

- May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through skin. Do not breathe spray mist.
- Causes skin and eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mix thoroughly before use or use entire container at one time. Gustafson Lindane 30C may be tank mixed with Vitavax® 200 Flowable Fungicide, Gustafson Vitavax-34 Seed Treatment, Gustafson's Captan 30-DD or Captan 300 or Gustafson 42-S Thiram Fungicide and Repellent at the respective labeled rate. All other tank mixes should be pre-tested to determine physical compatibility between formulations. Observe all cautions and limitations on labeling of all products used in mixtures.

This product is to be used in liquid or slurry treaters.

The Federal Food and Drug Administration has set official tolerances for certain pesticides residues. In order that residues on food and forage crops will not exceed established tolerances, use only at recommended rates.

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed or processed for oil. Seed commercially treated with Gustafson Lindane 30C must be labeled in accord with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not re-use empty container.
- STORAGE:** Store in a cool place. Do not store in direct sunlight. Protect from freezing temperatures.
