Use a portion of label directions to use this product in a manner consistent with labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

FROM BOTTLES: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Containment is prohibited. Do not reuse empty containers.

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put contents into or use into food or drink containers. Store in a cool, dry place. Protect from excessive heat. Do not store or transport near food or feed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GUSTAFSON VITAVAX CAPTAN 20-20 Seed Protectant is a formulation specifically designed for treatment of wheat, oat and barley seed on the farm at planting time. It controls covered smut (*Tilletia caries* and *Tilletia foetida*) and loose smut (*Ustilago nuda*) on wheat, covered smut (*Ustilago kyllbergii*) and loose smut (*Ustilago avenae*) of oats and covered smut (*Ustilago hordei*) and loose smut (*Ustilago nuda*) of barley. It also tends to reduce seed rot and seedling blight caused by soil fungi.

GUSTAFSON VITAVAX CAPTAN 20-20 Seed Protectant also controls various seed and seedling diseases of soybeans.

Soybeans Use 3 oz. per bushel. Apply as a planter box treatment, mixing thoroughly with the seed before planting. For best results, the following procedure is suggested. Fill planter box only half full of seed, add half the required amount of GUSTAFSON VITAVAX CAPTAN 20-20 Seed Protectant and mix thoroughly with a stick. Then add remainder of seed to planter box and add the rest of the required amount of product to the seed, again mixing thoroughly.

Good results are also obtained by premixing seed with the product in a suitable container, then pouring treated seed into planter box.

USE PRECAUTION

Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and separately launder clothing before reuse.

A dust mask must be worn when mixing and loading this product. If users/operators when mixing and loading this product must wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or a face shield and a chemically resistant apron. Field workers and harvesters must wear chemical resistant gloves. Leather or fabric gloves are not acceptable. **AFTER WORK:** Take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with captan must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.
