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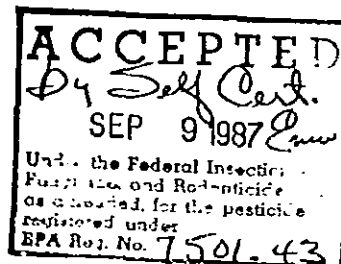

SOYBEANS

GUSTAFSON VITAVAX-CAPTAN 12.5-25 Seed Protectant
Use seed treatment which combines the systemic action of captan to control various diseases of soybeans. In addition, the essential soy molybdenum is present.

GUSTAFSON VITAVAX-CAPTAN 12.5-25 Seed Protectant
Application should be applied at the rate of 2 lb. of seed.

Apply as a planter box treatment, mixing thoroughly with the seed. For best results, the following procedure: planter box only half full of seed, add half the GUSTAFSON VITAVAX-CAPTAN 12.5-25 Seed Protectant thoroughly with a stick. Then add the remainder of seed and add the rest of the required amount of product to the box thoroughly.

Good results are also obtained by premixing seed in a suitable container, then pouring treated seed into the planter box.

USE PRECAUTION

Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wash hands and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing before reuse.

A dust mask must be worn when mixing and loading. Wear goggles or a face shield and a chemical resistant suit. Fieldworkers and harvesters must wear chemical resistant gloves or face shield. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash equipment with soap and water after each use. Periodic use must be laundered separately from other clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated with captan must be destroyed according to state law.
