

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid inhaling of dust. Do not use or store near food or feed.

During commercial exposure in seed treatment and loading operations, wear goggles, clean rubber gloves, protective clothing, and a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health under provisions of 30 CFR, Part 11. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Routinely shower or bathe after work; wash all clothing with soap and water before reusing.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages increase the toxic effects of thiram.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Drift or runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse container -- destroy when empty.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Protect from excessive heat. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not store or transport near food or feed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or residue is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your state pesticide or environmental control agency, or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Wheat, Oats, Barley

Apply at the rate of 4 ounces of product per 100 pounds of seed for the control of various seed rots and seedling diseases, including Rhizoctonia solani, loose smut, covered smut, flag smut (of wheat), common bunt, and barley stripe.

Use Restrictions: Do not use treated seed for food, feed or oil purposes. Do not graze or feed livestock on treated areas for six weeks after planting.
