STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Premix with the seed at the specified rates, directly in the planter box at planting. Seed treatments must be thoroughly mixed with the seed, and planters adjusted to the manufacturers directions (planting rates including air or vacuum may be affected by seed additives).
