STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

SWALLOWED: If swallowed drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. See a doctor.

Seed should be sound, well cured and cleaned prior to treatment. Use only the recommended rates of product per 100 pounds of seed.

At the recommended rates, apply Gustafson RTU-PCNB undiluted directly from the drum to the seed. If desired, add one part water to five parts Gustafson RTU-PCNB and recalibrate equipment so that recommended rates will still be applied. Slight agitation may be required to mix the material. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not feed treated seed to animals.

IMPORTANT:
