STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

CA MOLY provides 02 ounce of molybdenum per acre for plant nutrition and as an aid to the valuable nitrogen fixation process of the soybean plant. Measuring scoop enclosed.

**FOR PLANTER BOX APPLICATION
OR FOR USE ON SEED PRIOR TO PLACEMENT IN PLANTER BOX**

Do not use any water. Apply CAPT'N MOLY as a planter box treatment at the rate of 3.3 ounce (3 level SCOOPS) per bushel of soybean seed. Plant soybeans at the rate of one (1) bushel per acre for proper application of molybdenum. Treat half the seed in the planter box with half required CAPT'N MOLY and mix thoroughly with a stick or paddle until a uniform color imparted to all seed. Add the remaining seed and cover with balance of CAPT'N MOLY thoroughly as above. Plant as soon as possible. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.
