AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS

KODIAK A-T Fungicide will protect against seed and seedling rot diseases caused by *Pythium spp.* and *Rhizoctonia solani*.

PLANTER BOX TREATMENT

Apply at the specified rate and premix with the seed directly in the planter box at planting. Place half the amount of seed into the planter box and apply half the required amount of pesticide to the seed. Stir the seed thoroughly with a paddle until the seed is uniformly coated. Place the remaining half of the seed into the planter box and add the remaining half of the pesticide. Again stir the seed with the paddle until all seed is thoroughly coated. A non-oil lubricant has also been added to help seeds flow more easily and evenly from the planter box. Use the higher rate of application in fields with a history of severe disease pressure.

In California - Only for use in commercial seed treating establishments. Not allowed for "on-farm" use.

SEED TREATER APPLICATION

KODIAK A-T may be applied at planting time, utilizing commercial seed treating equipment to maximize seed coverage. (*Calibrate the equipment as per the manufacturer's instructions.)
