Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

When handlers use closed systems in a manner that meets the requirements listed in the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) for agricultural pesticides [40 CFR 170.240(d)(4-6)], the handler PPE requirements may be reduced or modified as specified in the WPS.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If **swallowed** - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If **inhaled** - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

GENERAL INFORMATION

Note: Thiophanate-methyl is a systemic fungicide having a specific mode of action which could be subject to development of resistant strains of fungi. Development of resistance cannot be predicted. Therefore, Gustafson, Inc. cannot assume liability for crop damage resulting from resistant strains of fungi. Consult with your State Agricultural Experiment Station or Extension Service Specialist for guidance and ways to control any possible resistant strains of fungi which may occur.

TOPS MZ is a fungicide formulated for the dry treatment of potato seedpieces to suppress *Fusarium* and *Rhizoctonia*. This pesticide will not control bacterial diseases or other diseases not claimed on this label. Consult your extension potato pathologist for variety and treatment information.

For the suppression of potato seedpiece decay caused by *Fusarium* and *Rhizoctonia* spp., use 1 pound TOPS MZ per 100 pounds of cut seedpieces. Apply by means of a seed dust metering applicator or dust attachment positioned over the belt so that the cut seedpieces are thoroughly covered with TOPS-MZ. Thoroughly clean and sanitize cutting machines, knives, trays, tables, barrels, equipment, trucks and planters before cutting

and planting seed pieces.

Do not use treated seed pieces for food, feed or fodder. Plant as soon as possible after cutting and treating in accordance with the basic recommendations of your State Potato Extension Specialist.

Apply only in areas with adequate ventilation or dust collection and control equipment installed. Do not substitute fans for ventilation in areas where application is made to cut potatoes.

NOTE: This pesticide is to be sold ONLY in this original, unbroken package.
