On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A), provided that you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. Make the changes to the label that are listed below before you release the product for shipment:
- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 7501-199".
- b. In the third paragraph of the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" section and the second paragraph of the "AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS" sections is the phrase "chemical-resistant gloves". In both cases this phrase must have "made of any waterproof material" added directly following it.
- c. In the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section, the last sentence reads "Cover or incorporate spilled treated seeds in accordance with local regulations." This appears to link the need to "cover or incorporate" with the presence of local regulations. Modify this to indicate that the user must "cover or incorporate", complying (while doing so) with any regulations that exist.

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- d. In the "USE PRECAUTION" section, change "...must be colored to distinguish and prevent subsequent..." to "...must be colored to distinguish it and prevent subsequent...".
- e. In the second to the last sentence in the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL" section change "...in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed..." to "...in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed...".
- 3. Submit, by December 31, 2004, studies intended to satisfy the Storage Stability (Guideline Requirement Number (GRN) 830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristics (GRN 830.6320) data gaps that currently exist for the subject product.
- 4. Submit one copy of your final printed label before you release this product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of all preceding conditions.

LABELING OF TREATED SEED

Seed commercially treated with Trifloxystrobin Flowable must be labeled in accordance with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act. All bags containing treated seed must be labeled or tagged as follows:

This seed has been treated with trifloxystrobin.

Do not use for feed, food or oil processing.

Store away from feeds and other foodstuffs.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Trifloxystrobin Flowable provides seed and seedling protection against seedborne funglicausing seed decay and the soilborne pathogen, *Rhizoctonia solani*. Apply as a seed treatment using standard slurry or mist-type seed treatment equipment. Uniform application of seed is necessary to ensure seed safety and best disease protection. Seed should be sound and well cured prior to treatment. Product should be diluted with sufficient water to ensure complete seed coverage. Consult a seed treatment specialist regarding slurry rates recommended for the crop to be treated with Trifloxystrobin Flowable. The length of control will vary depending on the rate used.

Cucurbit vegetable group, Fruiting vegetable group, Field corn, Pop corn, Rice, Sugar beet, Wheat, Potato (seed-piece), Peanut, Turf grass, Conifer, and Ornamental flowers: Apply at a rate of 0.32 – 0.64 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of seed.

ROTATIONAL CROP RESTRICTION

Treated areas may be replanted immediately with any crop for which a tolerance exists for trifloxystrobin. All crops without trifloxystrobin tolerances may be planted 30 days after seeding of trifloxystrobin-labeled crops.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal, or by cleaning of equipment. Do not reuse empty container. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry location.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Contact Gustafson or your chemical supplier for container return instructions. If container is not returned in accordance with instructions, triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
