DIRECTIONS BEFORE USE READ DIRECTIONS, PRECAUTIONS AND NOTICE STATEMENTS CAREFULLY

Two fluid tablespoons equal one fluid ounce

IMPORTANT: Do not use with soap or synthetic detergents. Materials to be sanitized and deodorized should first be washed and rinsed thoroughly. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

SUGGESTED USES FOR SUPERSWEET MULTI-PURPOSE DISINFECTANT: Farrowing houses, cattle sheds, hog finishing pens and poultry houses. Remove all livestock or poultry and feeds from premises, trucks, coops, crates. Remove all litter and droppings from floors, walls, and surfaces of facilities occupied or traversed by poultry or animals. Empty all troughs racks, and other feeding and watering appliances. Saturate surfaces with a solution made by mixing one tablespoon of SUPERSWEET MULTI-PURPOSE DISINFECTANT and one gallon of water (2 ounces in four gallons of water, 400 ppm.) Mop or spray thoroughly. Ventilate buildings and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry or animals or employ treated equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. All treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

DAIRIES: For sanitation of milk cans and miscellaneous dairy equipment, clean and rinse thoroughly, immerse in solution of one ounce of SUPERSWEET MULTI-PURPOSE DISIN-FECTANT in four gallons (200 ppm) of water for 2 minutes; air dry. Rinse in potable water before use. Use same solution for flank and udder washing before milking. Use a separate clean towel for each cow, never dip a used towel back into the disinfectant solution, prepare a fresh solution for each milking. Discard solutions if they become visibly soiled or turbid. To prevent residues in milk allow udder to air dry or dry with a clean towel before attaching to milker.

HATCHERIES: Remove all poultry and feeds from premises, trucks, coops, crates. Remove all litter and droppings from floors, walls and surfaces of facilities occupied or traversed by poultry. Empty all troughs, racks, and other feeding and watering appliances. Saturate surfaces with a solution of one ounce of SUPERSWEET MULTI-PURPOSE DISINFECTANT in two gallons (400 ppm) of water. Ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set, or dried. All treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains, and waterers must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water prior to reuse. For egg dipping for hatching eggs, one ounce of SUPERSWEET MULTI-PURPOSE DISINFECTANT in two gallons of water is recommended.


DISINFECTION OF CLOTHING: Prior to washing, soak clothing in a solution containing one ounce of SUPERSWEET MULTI-PURPOSE DISINFECTANT per gallon (800 ppm) of wat to disinfect clothing and linens.
