Revise Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), and Label

Purpose

The purpose of this submission is to replace the source of active ingredient for this product and to submit a revised CSF and revised label according to our December 4, 2003, letter, PR Notices 2001 and 2001-6.

CSF

Your CSF dated December 27, 2003, is acceptable. We have placed a copy in our files for this product. All other versions are obsolete.

Label

The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

- 1. In your ingredient statement, you must include the common name, "Warfarin", but you may, at your option, delete the chemical name, "3-(alpha-acetonylbenzyl-4-hydroxycoumacin".
- 2. Make this text the first sentence in your "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN":

If swallowed, Warfarin may reduce the clotting time of the blood and cause bleeding.
