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**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**SAN-I-QUEEN** is a high quality 6.4% liquid sodium hypochlorite solution. It is especially designed for application in "no-rinse" sanitizer of food contact surfaces and equipment. It is effective not only for kitchenware sanitation but also for use in low temperature style machines. **SAN-I-QUEEN** provides immediate chlorine release for rapid bactericidal action. It promotes free rinsing and protects food from contamination.

**TABLE OF PROPORTIONS**

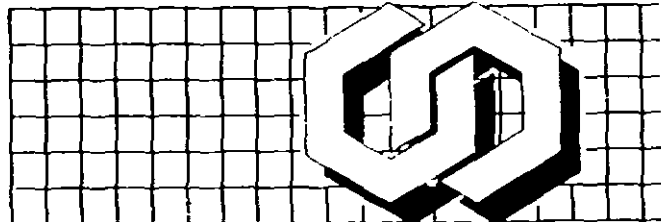
For 200 "p.p.m." available chlorine, use 2 oz. per 5 gallons of water. "ppm" means "parts per million" of available chlorine. **CAUTION: DO NOT** mix **SAN-I-QUEEN** with acid detergents. Degrades with age. Use a test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain required level of available chlorine.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Store this product in a cool dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid decomposition. In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Product or residues that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer. Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
