

SAN-I-QUEEN is one of the high quality components that make up the "ENERGY-SAVE" product system. It is a quality checked 6.40% sodium hypochlorite solution that is especially designed for use in low temperature dishmachine operations. It also should be applied as a "no-rinse" sanitizer of food contact surfaces and equipment.
