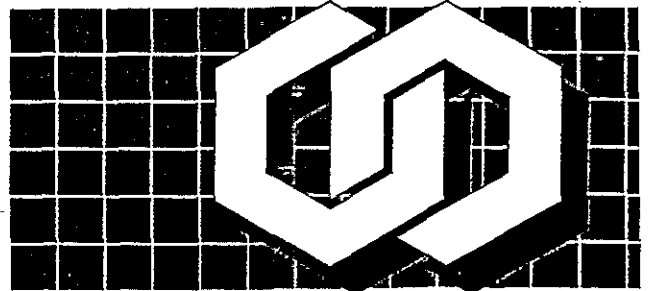
**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

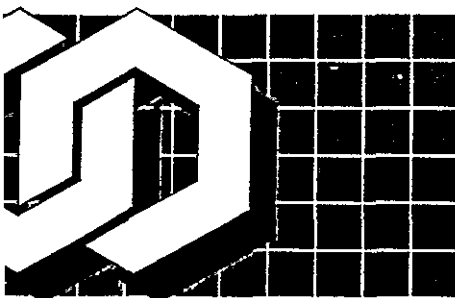

- Pre-flush and/or scrape utensils and glasses.
- Wash in a recommended manual detergent.

- Place sanitized utensils on a CLEAN, SANITIZED rail or drainboard to air dry. DO NOT mix with soaps, anionic wetting agents, or phenolic type germicides. \*ppm means "parts per million" of quaternary ammonium chloride.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Store this product in a cool, dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration. In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Product or rinsates that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer. Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection.
