**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** If Algae are visible, the open recirculating industrial cooling water system should be cleaned manually, or a dose not to exceed 80 ppm (3/4 lb. per 1,000 gallons of contained water) should be applied periodically until control is evident. Then the periodic dose should be reduced to 18 to 36 ppm (1/6 to 1/3 lb. to 1,000 gallons of contained water). **NOTE:** PPM (Parts per million) refer to total chlorophenate active ingredients.
