

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS **DANGER**

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water, unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit. For guidance contact the regional office of EPA. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this pesticide only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS OXIDIZING AGENT

Mix only with water. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may lead to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter or other chemicals or any foreign matter may start a chemical reaction, with generation of fire or explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseat container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary. Avoid any contact with flaming or burning material, such as a lighted cigarette.

STORAGE

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat and open flame. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage.

DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. Do not reuse empty container. Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment.
