The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Delete the statement "or bury in a safe place" from the Pesticide and Container Disposal section.
2. Delete the statement "Measures against circulatory shock respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed" from the Note to Physician statement.
3. Delete the statement "Only For Sale To, Use and Storage by Service Persons."
4. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read as follows:

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent



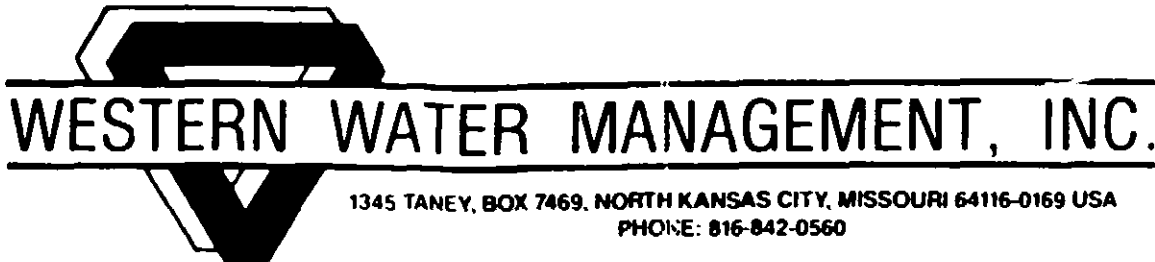

Algae & Slime Control NC-M Concentrated Liquid is for control of algae in recirculating water cooling towers in schools, hotels, hospitals and industry.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INITIAL DOSE: When microbial growth is evident, apply 3.3 to 6.6 fl. oz. per 1,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat dosage until control is evident. **SUBSEQUENT DOSE:** When control is evident apply 1.1 to 6.6 fl. oz. per 1,000 gallons of water contained, every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. Product may be applied at any point in the system where good mixing occurs. Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE AND CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse container and add rinsate to system according to the dosage given above. Dispose of container in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.

GENERAL: Consult Federal, State, or local disposal authorities for approved procedures.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water, unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit. For guidance, consult the Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DANGER

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of skin contact, wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
